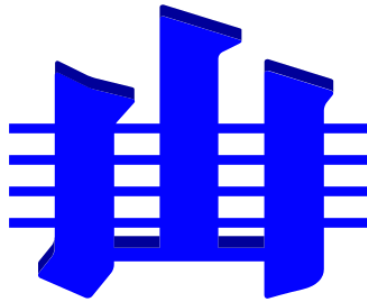


Subcommission on Permian Stratigraphy

An exceptional middle to late Permian tetrapod track fauna of Pangean Euramerica (Hornburg Formation, Germany) by **Daniel Falk**, University College Cork, School of Biological, Earth, and Environmental Sciences, Ireland.

Implications of the Permian-Triassic sedimentary gap for stratigraphic correlations and inferences on the paleogeography of SW Europe by **Joan Lloret Quirante**, Instituto de Geociencias (IGEO), CSIC-UCM, Madrid, Spain.

Correlating the continental end-Permian biome collapse (Lopingian) across eastern Australia by **Chris Mays**, Swedish Museum of Natural History, Stockholm, Sweden.

Sakmarian and Artinskian Conodonts from the Robledo Mountains (New Mexico) and correlation with the Carnic Alps and China by **Daniel Calvo Gonzalez**, University of Calgary, Canada.
